- Middle management or above, in all fields
- Senior official in local and central government (not elected officials)
- Professional occupations such as nurses, teachers, medical and dental practitioners, lawyers, veterinary surgeons, social workers, accountants, financial advisors, engineers, architects, draughts people, surveyors, scientists, librarians, clergy (please provide details and qualifications)
- Professional artists and writers
- Farmers and farm managers
- Commissioned Armed Forces officers and Senior non-commissioned officers
- Personal assistants and senior secretaries
